- I. Part 1: 25 points: All questions in Part 1 are answered and fully explained. Complete sentences are used where necessary. Your handwriting is neat and your island location is marked.
- II. Part 2: 75 points: All tasks within Part 2 are complete. Individual tasks will be assessed as follows:

A. 5 points:	Title	A Capitalized Title (name of your country) appears on the map
B. 5 points:	Scale	An accurate and realistic scale bar is included
C. 5 Points:	Compass	A compass rose that meets the minimum requirements is included
D. 10 Points:	Legend	A complete and readable legend with at least 10 symbols is included
E. 25 Points:	Map Human & Physical Features	The map must include a mix of human and physical features. Features should be named on the map and symbolized in the legend (ex: name features such as cities, mountains, bodies of water, etc). Your map should have at least one city, harbor, and port (there could be many).
F. 25 Points:	Neatness, Realism & Accuracy	The map is neat, realistic, and accurate. The size and location of the island are realistic, as are the items included on the map. Proper nouns are capitalized, and writing is horizontal.
